### REGIONAL TOPICS FOR SCFNA AREA REVIEW

1. **NCRSC PROPOSED BUDGET REQUIRES SCFNA APPROVAL** For the new fiscal year (Jul 2022 through Jun 2023), the NCRSC Draft Action Plan and its associated NCRSC Proposed Budget was presented and now **requires SCFNA AREA vote of approval** before July 9. The proposed budget is expected to be overseeing \$105,585, and is the result of the Environmental Scan Report.

3. **NCCNA 44** Will Be In Sacramento, CA (April 6 – 9, 2023)
  - a. Our area, SCFNA, has been approved for the Registration Committee. Congrats to our area!
4. (a) **DRT/MAT LITERATURE:** As medically assisted treatment has become a standard practice for the treatment of addiction, those coming to our rooms are often on DRT/MAT. Our challenge, as a Fellowship, is how to welcome these members so that they are able to make an informed decision for themselves and come to know that drug free recovery in NA is possible. You may want to read the PR pamphlet Narcotics Anonymous and Persons Receiving Medically Assisted Treatment before completing this survey or holding local discussions. NAWS posted a survey on drug replacement therapy/medication assisted treatment (DRT/MAT) as it relates to NA. Background: WSC 2018 passed a motion to frame a project plan to create a piece of service literature on this topic. WSC 2020 approved motions "to accept DRT/MAT as it relates to NA—**What do we want to say in a piece of NA literature? as our first Issue Discussion Topic**" and to approve a Fellowship survey about the topic. Check out the survey [www.na.org/survey](http://www.na.org/survey) and share your thoughts.

The NA Fellowship has been wrestling with this subject before 1996 at a time when DRT/MAT became an established medical protocol (e.g., methadone, suboxone, etc.) and the NA Fellowship needed a consistent message then.

NA published this 2016 pamphlet on the subject, and this 1996 Service Bulletin:

- Has a Narcotics Anonymous and Persons Receiving Medication-Assisted Treatment
- Bulletin 29, Regarding Methadone and Other Drug Replacement Programs; service pamphlet, NA Groups and Medication

We are a complete "abstinence" fellowship, with perhaps an 8-16% membership on DRT/MAT, and growing. Challenge questions: Are these members to remain "silent" at every meeting (as the current literature states)?

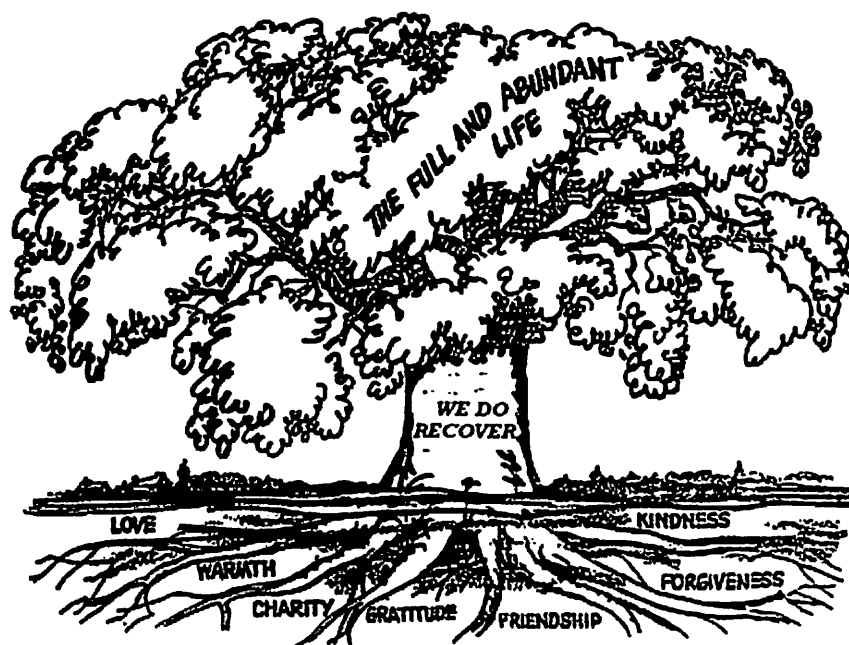

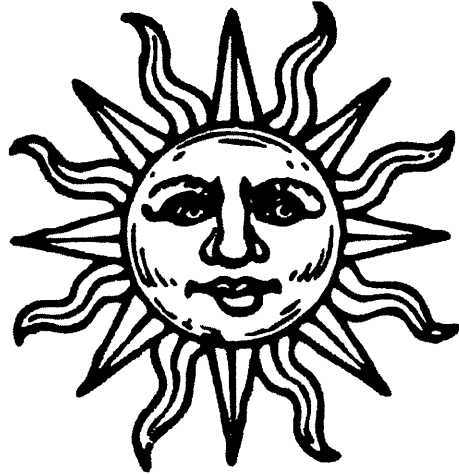
