### **MOTION TO AMEND SCFNA AREA GUIDELINES:**

### Page 1. Under Number 4, FUNCTIONS

**D.** To maintain a checking account with Chair, Vice-chair, Treasurer, and Secretary as authorized signatories. Two signatures are required for any withdrawal of funds. The ASC shall maintain a prudent reserve equal to 2/12 (two-twelfth) 1/4 (one quarter) of the previous year's expenses, to be calculated at the annual budget meeting in October.

Intent: To ensure that SCFNA reserves sufficient funds to continue functioning for at least three full months. Recommended business practice is to hold three to six months of expenses.

### **MOTION TO AMEND SCFNA AREA GUIDELINES**

Page 10. Section D, Disbursement of ASC Funds - Add #6.

6. No SCFNA ASC Committee or Sub-committee may hold a debit or credit card attached to an SCFNA bank account.

Intent: To protect SCFNA funds. ASC has no debit or credit card. The ASC committee and subcommittees are required to have two signatures on each check. There is no such protection with an ATM or credit card. There is significant potential for loss of SCFNA funds as the ASC committee and subcommittees hold thousands of dollars in their bank accounts.

- 2. **Norcan / Naloxone**: NA Insurance does not cover a "group" or "trusted servants" to administer Norcan to the public.
- Resources for H&I and PR now available: <u>Extensive resources</u> (presentations, videos) are now available for your local group and committees to "adapt and tailor" to quickly make presentations and to better answer questions consistently.
- 4. Collaboration of US Zones: Please share this Youtube video <u>About US</u> <u>Collaboration of Zones</u> with your area and groups and help develop our <u>regional</u> <u>conscience</u>. The video is a presentation and poses this question: <u>Does your region</u> <u>support the zones of the US forming a service body to collaborate?</u>
  US Zones would be able to address gaps in the current service structure, including: centralized technology for a national PR website/phone line, Fellowship Development (FD)/Outreach, assist in providing national PSA's, improve access to workshops & training material across the all the Regions in the US to grow our local NA communities. <u>Your SCFNA RCM requests feedback from subcommittees in support of this initiative</u>.
- 5. Regional Treasurer Report & Financials:
  - a. **New Treasurer:** A new regional treasurer was elected into service, RSC Treasurer, Lorie C <u>rsctreasurer@ncrsc.org</u>. The position was critical to making decisions and moving forward. Many thanks to the outgoing treasurer, PattyS from Sonoma County, for doing a most outstanding and amazing job!
  - b. **Group Insurance:** Regional insurance bill was paid \$19,603.70 insuring your area and groups are covered by the insurance policy. Does your group meet in a facility requiring proof of insurance? - c. NorCal Region is still holding \$21,596.84 in encumbered funds, to be "released" in October. In the absence of additional action in October from the RSC, 20% of these funds would move to our available discretionary and the rest would be donated to NAWS. If the body chose to in October, it could also decide to use these funds to fill the budget "shortfall" which is explained as: .
  - i. Please let your area and local NA groups know that regional donations are currently *substantially* behind projections. While the hole in our prudent reserve is currently only \$1,492.64, our projected monthly income from donations was \$8,606.24 (which at the time we thought was conservative). However, actual donations for the first three months have averaged only \$5,373.83, or \$3,232.41 per month less than projected. Should this continue, we would have a shortfall of \$38,788.92 in revenue vs. what we projected. Some expenses will be less than projected, but will be insignificant to the overall shortfall.

Your SCFNA RCM requests guidance and suggestions from the SCFNA ASC, JAC, GSR's. At the moment, your RCM is going to make a motion at region in October to retain the encumbered funds further until the next 12 month RSC budgets can be reviewed and discussed in depth, in relation to the NCCNA.

- 6. NCCNA 44 Sacramento, CA (April 6 9, 2023)
  - a. Assistant Treasurer the motion passed allowing access to the online bank account despite the bylaws does not have them as a signer - issue around not "voted-in" position
  - b. NCCNA Final Budget
  - c. NCCNA serves at the request of your local NA groups within the Northern California region. Your local group needs to be aware that costs of running the annual convention are sharply increasing. To get steep discounts for NA members attending conventions, NCCNA must reserve convention halls several years in advance, make substantial down payments for hotel rooms, convention halls, merchandise. All of these costs are rapidly rising.

Problem: a sharp increase in cash flow problems. A lot of expenses occur many months before income starts to roll in. Managing the financial risk has the attention of the greatest minds in NA.

NCCNA prudent operating reserve has been increased from \$150k to \$200k. NCCNA 44 (upcoming April 2023) is budgeting income of \$323,350, expense, \$317,455, net income of only \$5,895. Compare to pre-pandemic NCCNA 41 (April 2018) of \$302,741.32, expenses \$238,969.43, and net income of \$63,771.89
