MOTION TO AMEND SCFNA AREA GUIDELINES

Page 10. Section D, Disbursement of ASC Funds - Add #6.

6. No SCFNA ASC Committee or Sub-committee may hold a debit or credit card attached to an SCFNA bank account.

Intent: To protect SCFNA funds. ASC has no debit or credit card. The ASC committee and subcommittees are required to have two signatures on each check. There is no such accountability or protection with an ATM or credit card. There is significant potential for loss of SCFNA funds as the ASC committee and subcommittees hold thousands of dollars in their bank accounts.

Page 10. Section D, Disbursement of ASC Fund – Add #7

7. ACH and Paypal may be used only by the ASC Treasurer only for <u>recurring</u> monthly or annual payments approved by two signers on the ASC bank account.
