Regardless of insurance policies held by meeting facilities, **bringing a pet to a meeting puts that meeting, its members, and NA as a whole at risk.** NCRSO's insurance policy DOES NOT provide coverage for pets of any kind at meetings. The only exception is if a person needs the assistance of a service animal as defined in the Americans with Disabilities Act. The presence of ANY animal not meeting the ADA definition of "Service Animal" could cause a claim to be denied by NCRSO's insurance company. There are the two questions that can legally be asked.

When it is not obvious what service an animal provides, only limited inquiries are allowed. The two questions are:

- a. Is the dog a service animal required because of a disability?
- b. What work or task has the dog been trained to perform?

Members cannot ask about the person’s disability, require medical documentation, require a special identification card or training documentation for the dog, or ask that the dog demonstrate its ability to perform the work or task.

By paying careful attention to the information provided in this document, groups can help ensure the financial welfare of Narcotics Anonymous by avoiding unnecessary legal conflicts.
