- a. **NCCNA** April 6-9, 2023 will be the convention in Sacramento.
  - i. **Pre-registration : Pre-registration closes Fri, March 17 for the full package with merchandise.** Registration closes Mar 26 for the smaller no merchandise package. Hyatt and Sheraton are full - but check often for cancellations. Remember to check hotels in the adjacent area.
  - ii. **NCCNA Record Your Share for NA YouTube:** The NorCal Na PR/H&I Sharing Forum invites you to share your Experience, Strength, and Hope on video at NCCNA XLIV Saturday, April 8, 2023, 9:00 A.M.—4:00 P.M. Each "Share" is 15-20 minutes long and will be up-loaded to a private YouTube Channel, accessed through the NorCalNa website. The Shares can be used at both H&I and regular NA meetings. For more information, call Tom H., 530-867-7825. The location for filming will be available at the PR/H&I Booth.

- **Impassioned Appeal to Better Serve Hispanic & Deaf Communities:** the "Spanish Speaking RCM" [spana-rcm1@ncrsc.org](mailto:spana-rcm1@ncrsc.org) spoke on the need to remain open to and inclusive of all addicts. His area is reaching out to other Areas in the Region to help get Spanish speaking persons the resources they need in NA.

"Spanish Speaking Area - SPANA" of our Region has NA literature in Spanish available for NA groups.

From the PR Handbook: *"Addiction crosses all cultural boundaries; the absence at our meetings of individuals from a certain cultural group doesn't mean that no one from that culture suffers from addiction or needs what we have to offer. Asking questions like **Who in our community is missing from our meetings?** and **Who in our community does NA need to reach?** will help to focus service efforts where they are needed the most. Having group discussions about the area's goals will help to focus PR efforts."*

- a. We are seeing about 6 - 10 Hispanic members attending SCFNA meetings - many of whom speak little English. Anyone willing to consider forming an NA Group with a Spanish speaking format?
  - b. We are seeing a growing number of minors attending SCFNA meetings - and we are being asked if there are any safe "young people's groups" for them to meet.
  - c. We are being asked to provide the NA message to the hearing impaired.
  - d. Does the SCFNA Helpline have Spanish helpline volunteers & menus?
- **Signing Liability Waivers at NA Sponsored Events :** RSC discussed the question posed by the SCFNA area regarding the need for outside facilities requiring individuals to sign their full name to attend an NA event. Bottomline: these waivers are a remedy to satisfy a facilities' insurance liability requirements and are an outside issue.
  - **Narcan at NA Meetings:** Several months ago, the RCM report discouraged members acting in their role as NA trusted servants from administering Narcan at any NA meeting or event. This topic comes up occasionally at various group business meetings. The NCRSO BOD President reports: "We checked with our insurance company regarding Narcan and the reply is; *"If Narcan should be administered? This should not be something NCRSO should consider."*
  - **Claims Made to our NA Insurance:** to the question posed by SCFNA member, the NCRSO BOD President reports "We checked with our insurance broker regarding any losses, and from 6/2020 to present that has been NO claims or payouts. We have requested additional loss runs prior to 2020." Is there any further information needed?
  - **Event Insurance:** Areas in the Region were inspired by the SCFNA events, in particular the Broomball. They commented they had to stop having these events a

few years ago because they couldn't get the NA insurance. They have asked for help in wording the insurance request so they can revive having these events in their areas.

- **NA Guidelines:** The RSC, ASC, and WSC committees are regularly working to improve their guidelines and promote better practices. Over the past six months, the RSC has identified several guideline subjects that can be considered for review by the SCFNA ASC Guidelines Ad-Hoc team. These include compliance with ADA regulations, procedures for area voting and seating of NCCNA trusted servants, oversight of technology access to prevent hostage situations, and ensuring adherence to insurance requirements for subcommittee meetings and events. Additionally, the [ASC Guidelines of Marin County Fellowship](#) have recently been updated. - **NA & Social Media** - An NA member in our region created a Facebook group page, which raised questions about the involvement of ASC or other subcommittees and groups. To address these questions, members can refer to literature on NA's approach to social media, including "[Social Media & Our Guiding Principles](#)" and a related PowerPoint presentation, "[Social Media & Our Guiding Principles Powerpoint.](#)" These resources offer guidance and examples of situations where social media use has caused some shocking scenarios, and can be resources to help areas navigate the social media landscape more effectively in practice and guidelines.
- **Contra Costa Area** : Having a problem keeping their area functioning. They are considering consolidating subcommittees, perhaps breaking up the area, using SSP, etc.

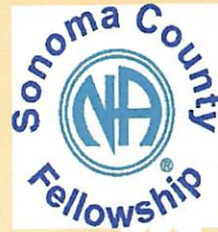
