

• **RD/AD Representation at WSC**: On April 19, 2023, a unique circumstance arose concerning the representation of our regional conscience at the WSC. The Alternate Delegate (AD) is unable to attend the event, while the Regional Delegate (RD) is



scheduled to be present. To ensure that both votes of the RD/AD were accounted for at the World Service Conference, prompt action was required to fill the AD position before the WSC held from April 30 to May 6.

- FST & RCM members of the NCRSC agreed via email to support the appointment of Michelle S., who was a Regional Delegate at the 2016 World Service Conference, replacing Amy, our current AD.
