Our annual searching and fearless "Regional Inventory" cycle is beginning—an annual opportunity for collaboration and strategic planning. We value your input on how NA funds should be allocated over the next two years.

Join us in shaping the future of your NA region by taking a brief, inclusive "Regional Inventory Survey"

Your feedback is essential in guiding our decisions. Together, let's make a positive impact.

Regional Inventory Process: Our process is to "gather information" from the SCFNA area, and "prioritize issues to be addressed" by using the questions below (see <u>RSC Guidelines</u> Appendix A-2 Regional Inventory), using the <u>NAWS Planning Basics</u> handbook, <u>Planning Basic & Regional Inventory (PPT)</u>:

- a. How well has the Regional Service Committee performed over the prior two (2) years in serving the Areas, and how can it better serve them in the coming years?
- b. How well has the Regional Service Committee served the larger NA community, and how can the RSC better serve the community-at-large?
- c. How well has the Regional Service Committee supported NA's Regional and World Services? How can the RSC provide better support for these services?
- d. Your RCM's see the need to ask this question: What are the three greatest challenges facing the SCFNA Area?

RSC Action Plan: The answers above will be used by the FST to create the "Action Plan" which RSC uses for the coming 12 months of the RSC term (July 2023-June

2024).

RSC 2023-2024 Budget: Based on the "Action Plan" a budget will be created for the RSC term (July 2023-June 2024). NCRSO: Lease ends July 2024, with a \$3795 (\$45,540 annually) reduction to \$3000 subsidy from NCRSC starting now for the next 12 months (\$36,000 annually). How would you like your regional budget of \$105K-\$110K spent?

SCFNA Area ASC Voting: Sonoma County Fellowship NA (SCFNA) is considering various options on the voting rights of its Area Service Committee (ASC). Currently, both the Joint Administration Committee (JAC) and Group Service Representatives (GSRs) have voting rights, but SCFNA is exploring a structure where only GSRs would have voting rights, excluding JAC members, or a combination thereof.

This topic was discussed at the Regional Service Committee (RSC) with representatives from 20 out of 23 areas, revealing a mix of voting approaches in our region driven by special needs. With other areas, voting privileges have evolved around the ratio of GSR to JAC members, number of groups in the area, distances for travel, hybrid vs in-person committees, "recovery & service" experience of the area, access to ASC meeting facility, etc.

Electronic polling of Regional Committee Members (RCMs) will be conducted next month, and the results will be reported to SCFNA to help give an informed view of possibilities.

2021-2022 NAWS Annual Report PDF | Digital The NAWS Financial Overview explains that member contributions are holding steady at 24% of NAWS operating income again this fiscal year.



Group & Individual Contributions: IP-24 Money Matters: Self-Support in NA describes how your contributions can best serve the fellowship It encourages individuals and groups to contribute directly to each level of service, fostering stability and reliability within our fellowship. Consider contributing as follows: 50% to the local area, 25% to the region, and 25% to world services. By aligning our efforts and investing in our communities, we strengthen our collective mission and extend our reach to those in need.

PPP Loans: Sonoma County Fellowship members asked about the money NA World Services received during the pandemic shutdown. Here is an excerpt from the 2021-2022 Annual Report (**PDF | Digital**):

NOTE 9 - PPP LOAN

On April 21, 2020 and February 19, 2021, NAWS entered into loan agreements with City National Bank in the amount of \$676,740 and \$517,150, respectively, under the Paycheck Protection Program ("PPP"). The PPP, established as part of the CARES Act, provides for loans to qualifying businesses for certain expenses, including payroll costs, continuation of group health care benefits, rent, utilities, and interest on certain other debt obligations. The loans bear interest at a rate of 1.0% per annum and mature April 23, 2022 and February 22, 2026. The loan and accrued interest are forgivable under some circumstances. On October 6, 2021, NAWS received notice the SBA had reviewed the forgiveness application of their first PPP loan and provided forgiveness of their PPP loan in the amount of \$563,362. The remaining balance of \$113,378 was paid by NAWS during the year ended June 30, 2022. On September 8, 2022, NAWS received notice the SBA had reviewed the forgiveness application of their second PPP loan and provided forgiveness of their PPP loan in the amount of \$517,150.

NOTE 10 - SBA LOAN

On July 7, 2020, NAWS entered into an agreement with The Small Business Administration for a loan in the amount of \$150,000. The loan bears interest at a rate of 2.75% per annum and matures July 7, 2050, with monthly payments commencing January 1, 2023. The following is a schedule of future minimum loan payments as of June 30, 2022: Year ending June 30, 2023 \$ 2,727 * 2024 5,455 * 2025 5,455 * 2026 5,455 * 2027 5,455. Thereafter 125,453. Total minimum payments required \$ 150,000

NCCNA: Convention April 6-9 had 4204 paid registrations, 176 newcomer packages, for a total of 4380 in attendance. Two motions made, first to mandate a minimum of 5 years clean time and second, referenceable closing of the books. NA caused \$3500 in damages to the convention center and NCCNA will pay from internal funds rather than making an insurance claim to avoid escalating future year insurance rates.

RD/AD: Michelle sat in as acting AD. Michael (RD) and Amy (AD) remain in their positions until the end of term, June 30, 2023. Our World Service Conference 2023 has just completed as of May 6. Here are the voting results for all the motions: <u>WSC Summary of Decisions</u>

NCRSC Treasurer Audit: A team conducted a financial review of the accounting records of the Northern California Region Service Committee (NCRSC) for the period from June 2019 to December 2022. The review covered a total of 31 months, noting that NCRSC's fiscal year runs from July to June. The next financial review will commence with the remaining final

months of the current fiscal period, from January 2023 to June 2023. Below are the results of our review.


