

This means that anyone willing to be of service on the RSC (either an RCM or FST member), can attend online or in-person. Hybrid meetings are a great option for service opportunities for those that prefer to not travel.

**NCCNA 45** Alternative Store Information. The NCCNA committee is asking for area conscience on the possibility of changing NCCNA policy to allow vendors to sell at the store on Sundays with the support of their area. Intent: give a fundraising opportunity for areas that can make financial arrangements with merchandise vendors.

To change the SCFNA Area Guidelines, Page 8, under members, section B, number 13, adding the sentence in red below: No standing Subcommittee shall operate without operational guidelines approved by the ASC. All subcommittees are required to give an oral report at each regular ASC meeting and a written report to the ASC secretary. Subcommittees with separate bank accounts are required to submit a financial report and monthly bank statement, along with their written report. Subcommittees with separate bank accounts may accept payments for fellowship events or merchandise through P2P payment systems (e.g., Venmo, PayPal, CashApp), using accounts in the Subcommittee's name with its banking information.

Intent: By implementing this solution, the Fellowship can enhance the payment experience for both the subcommittees and their supporters, increasing engagement and participation within the Fellowship by providing convenient ways to access events and merchandise. Maker: Tania Second: A...



### DELETE:

3. After paying all expenses and encumbering funds for projected expenses, all funds that exceed the established "Prudent Reserve" will be sent to the NCRSC, in the form of a donation.

### **CHANGE TO:**

- 3. The financial guidelines regarding contributions of SCFNA are as follows:
  - a. Monthly Contribution Handling
    - Minimum Monthly Contribution: The SCFNA will make a minimum monthly contribution to NCRSC in the amount of \$50.
    - 2. Maximum Total Contribution: After paying all monthly expenses, any SCFNA funds exceeding the prudent reserve will be contributed to the NCRSC, up to a maximum of \$500. The maximum contribution will be reevaluated every year in March (which is a half-year evaluation).
    - 3. Excess Funds: The retained excess funds, along with the prudent reserve, will be available for use by the SCFNA when needed until the annual budget meeting.
  - b. Yearly Contribution Handling
    - 1. Fiscal Year Allocation: In September the excess funds in the SCFNA bank account (above prudent reserve) will be evaluated to determine if a higher prudent reserve is needed. If required, the funds will be used to fulfill the higher prudent reserve first.
    - 2. Contribution to NCRSC: After ensuring the prudent reserve is met or exceeded, any remaining excess funds will be contributed to the NCRSC.

INTENT: This contribution structure allows SCFNA to stabilize its feast or famine financial cycles while also delivering more regular and consistent contributions to NCRSC.
