What does a trusted servant do when someone starts talking about a specific religion?

- Person introduced themselves as a “Christian” and the second day introduced themselves as “A Believer”. It created controversy.
- What is the protocol for a trusted servant when this happens?
- Experienced member shared – someone interrupts and informs the person that it is an outside book or issue and in violation of our traditions.
- Handle it with tact and simply state it is violation of traditions.
- Concern about if we would alienate the newcomer or person inappropriately sharing. Is private chat appropriate? Many members think so
- Can lead to arguments and disunity after meeting. How do you address that? Serenity prayer or do nothing – be okay with disagreements
- Can call yourself whatever you want – we can’t police what people say – but by referring to ourselves as addicts it unifies us. Reading outside lit is an issue
- Take someone to the side and talk to them about it. (chat)
- Can the co-host or host put the clarity statement in the chat? Might have a lot of still to add into the readings.
- Say serenity prayer if there are arguments or heated debate.
- Inform privately and speak up after to remind group that we are not a religious program. Refer to NA literature when possible.
