

AREA TOPICS (Sonoma County Fellowship of NA - SCFNA)

Area Inventory Update: Your Feedback in Action! RCMs have collected and compiled the unedited written and online responses from the SCFNA groups, GSRs, and members at the Sept ASC. We've received valuable suggestions for area-wide solutions. Coincidentally, some of these suggestions are already being incorporated into the newly proposed ASC Guidelines. Please review their ad-hoc report on this matter. There are a many suggestions requiring ongoing discussions. Therefore, tonight, Oct 19 at ASC, we are passing out a flier announcing the formation of an ad-hoc team to turn the Area Inventory responses into a 2024 Area Action Plan. The ad-hoc is scheduled to meet the 2nd Sunday of each month @ 3pm-4:30pm, starting Jan 14, 2024, at the Area offices in Rohnert Park in-person and also online. See flier: Area Action Plan Ad-Hoc. This Ad-Hoc team will transform the 2023 Area Inventory into a 2024 Area Action Plan. We'll address all your "needs improvement" comments, using the successful strategies that are already in place.

RSO

The RSO is facing a lease renewal decision with the current landlord, set to expire in the upcoming June. The proposed lease term is for five years at a rate of \$207,060. This lease is non-negotiable in terms of an early termination clause ("no-out").

Given the significant financial implications and commitment, RCMs have requested that the RSO present three alternative lease proposals to the RSC, which should also include professional moving costs in case relocation becomes necessary. These discussions have arisen as the RSO has requested several facility repairs, and in response, the landlord has offered the new five-year lease. The current lease is scheduled to expire June 30, 2024.

This situation has raised questions regarding the urgency of signing the contract to ensure the repairs are completed by December-January and to secure the current lower rates. Furthermore, there is a need for clarification on whether the proposed rates have an expiration date and whether there are any negotiable conditions for lease termination beyond the standard Force Majeure clause, which typically covers uncontrollable events or "acts of God."

RSC Treasurer Audit

The RSC Treasurer Audit was completed for Jan 2023-Jun 2023. A report will be coming out next month.

Our current vision is to have three H&I Basics – one focused on corrections, drug courts, and sponsorship behind the walls; another focused on carrying the message into treatment facilities; and one more on H&I committees and their function. We need and want your help to revise our H&I resources to illustrate the range of current H&I experience.






