PUBLIC RELATIONS REPORTS

- **Phone Line Coordinator:** Our SCFNA Helpline is open all day, every day 24/7. **We're looking for volunteers to help answer calls from addicts who need support.** If you can volunteer for a time-slot, please submit your contact info and availability using the online form "[HelpLine Volunteer Signup Sheet](#)" or send an email note to PR-Team@sonomacountyna.org
- **PCC (Public Communications Coordinator): PR 2024 Outreach :** With the PR-PCC role filled, "PR 2024 Outreach" is underway, leveraging SCFNA's enhanced ability to disseminate the NA message among public professionals capable of referring addicts. This initiative is identifying a range of individuals from parole and probation officers to attorneys, law enforcement, *PACT Panel*¹, county supervisors, SLE's, and educators at SSU & SRJC, in collaboration with the county's support and digital tools.
 - To better engage these professionals, SCFNA PR will be updating the "[Information For Professionals](#)" which is the dedicated webpage on the SCFNA's website. Standardized communication materials for letters, emails, information pamphlets, will all be written with links directed to our website for further details. The updated webpage will detail SCFNA's offerings and guide on how to request services, including literature, racks, schedules, presentations, and workshop coordination.
 - We encourage SCFNA members to forward any impactful contacts—your personal and professional networks can serve as crucial links to the community.
 - Additionally, we're seeking ways for agencies to host NA-centric events, enhancing community outreach.

¹ PACT: Parole and Community Team. PACT presents valuable information to freshly paroled individuals. The Sonoma County PACT is a panel of county resources comprised of agencies such as Catholic Charities, JobLink, Social Services, SRJC. NA is represented on the panel by two SCFNA members.

- **Schedule Coordinator:** We're adjusting our schedule printing strategy. Since COVID-19, we've been printing approximately 1,000 schedules monthly, with minimal changes. For March 2024, we'll print 1,400 schedules, then switch to bi-monthly printing, skipping April for a May print. This change will save about \$600 annually.
 - Please verify your meeting details on our SCFNA NA website matches the printed schedule and that BOTH locations are accurate, especially meeting "key code" formats. Notify us of any meetings to remove, or change.
 - Remember, you can print schedules from the bottom of the home page of our website, <https://sonomacountyna.org>, on your personal printer.

- **Community & Schools Coordinator:** Petaluma HS confirmed days and times for presentations this semester: March 29: Morning from 8:30 finished by 10:05am, for one period, April 1: All day, 8:30am finished by 2:55pm, for three periods. We have 4 presenters for each day confirmed. Thank-you everyone for helping us get the message of NA into our local High Schools!

- **Social Media:** We are now up to 136 followers on Instagram² (@sonomacountyna). PR posts daily "Just For Today" in audio & video format, along with upcoming NA Events, and convention information.

- **Fliers:** The motion to adopt "Flier Guidelines" was not approved by the ASC for its ASC Guidelines in Feb, leaving the flier requirements open to interpretation. PR requests feedback from ASC on their preferences for handling fliers. According to the NAWS PR Handbook, NA avoids publishing personal information publicly whenever possible. PR seeks ASC agreement that ASC Fliers will only be published if they adhere to these following specifics:
 - Submit fliers for posting by emailing them in JPG, PDF, PNG, or video format to postevents@sonomacountyna.org. These will be shared on various NA public-facing platforms including area, regional, zonal, and world websites, as well as multiple social media channels.
 - NA Logo must appear on the flier for any NA announcement or event, and must have the registered trademark clearly visible to legally protect the NA property. The endorsing (approving) service body (Group, Area, Region, Zone, NAWS) must be visible on the flier, video, media.

- Subcommittees and groups should use their @sonomacountyna.org email address and include the SCFNA Helpline number (707) 324-4062, with the appropriate extension, available at <https://sonomacountyna.org/contact>
- Any group flier event announcement, without a “generic” non-personal email, can easily establish an email with any email service provider, or contact PR to obtain one prior to printing or distributing their fliers, if they wish them to be publicly published on NA services. As Groups move more into P2P payments info on fliers, this becomes even more important.
- **Advertising Recovery:** The Sonoma County Fellowship is currently divided over the 'attraction' versus 'promotion' concepts, which is preventing the Public Relations team from enhancing public awareness of the NA message through methods like billboards and PSAs. Our previous proposed budget failed due to this lack of consensus back in December.

PR requests that SCFNA Area consider an area-wide discussion to clarify these principles, particularly the 11th Tradition of NA, which stresses the importance of attracting rather than promoting to preserve anonymity and integrity. Misunderstandings have led some members to believe that *promoting recovery* contradicts NA's principles, where some believe the tradition was primarily established to prevent *promoting individuals* or *promoting celebrities*, risking the organization's public image should an individual relapse.

We would like to propose raising awareness at the area level through various means such as educational flyers, engaging discussions, and inviting regional representatives to demystify these concepts and help SCFNA to develop better public outreach strategies.

We could consider collaborating a learning day workshop with other areas experienced in this matter, or seeking guidance from regional members may be of benefit. We are asking for guidance from the SCFNA area on how to best explore 'attraction versus promotion' in detail.

Purpose

The goal of the ad-hoc team has been to:

- **GOAL: Simplify questions for the next Area Inventory (Aug 2024).**

PROGRESS: In 2023, we followed the standard format from the NAWS Public Relations Handbook. Groups gave feedback that indicated SCFNA could benefit from tailored Area Inventory questions. We're drafting new survey questions aimed at providing timely feedback to subcommittees for their 2025 planning which they begin in September 2024.

April: Based on the above timelines, we will be submitting the suggested new Area Inventory survey question at the April ASC meeting,

May: Subcommittees and groups to review and give their feedback.

Jun: The next Area Inventory is scheduled to be sent out by the RCM's to be tabled to all GSR groups.

Jul: Responses will be tabulated into a report to ASC

Aug: Per the ASC Guidelines, "Section F Area Inventory to be conducted annually, in August."

- **GOAL: Create 2024 Action Plans to Address 2023 Feedback from Groups.**

- We have made the **fully redacted** FINAL Area Inventory REPORT from the ad-hoc available for every member to review: 2024 SCFNA Area Action Plan Ad-hoc - AREA REPORT.

- Please refer to our minutes from last month for the details on the number of GSR's and members that contributed to the Area Inventory and how we tabulated the final report.

- **Adopt-an-Action Topic Themes:** Based on your invaluable feedback, we crafted a list of seven critical topics requiring our area's attention. Last month, five enthusiastic GSRs committed to adopting these topics, with four attending the productive March ad-hoc meeting and an additional subcommittee representative joining the cause. These are the topics now under the diligent stewardship of our GSRs, set to invigorate our area's conscience:
 - Empowering GSRs to better shape decisions at ASC (championed by GSR: We Meeting & GSR Night Light). Report to be presented at ASC in April.
 - How to better inform your group of all of the information shared at Area, including what tools do you need (championed by GSR: BNB) to be presented at ASC May.
 - What Leadership skills look like, what makes an effective leader in NA service? What are your groups looking for in Trusted Servant Leadership? Championed by the GSR Sounds of Recovery & GSR Shelter from the Storm, tentatively presented in June.
- No GSR's signed up to spear-head these topics:
 - How to better inform your group of all of the information shared at Area, including what tools do you need? What information do you share at the group meeting, at the business meeting, or just make available for members?
 - What questions do you think are important for future Area Inventories. Are we asking the right questions about how ASC serves the groups? Where do you think ASC falls short in serving your group, and can you suggest some solutions that we can use to measure our progress in the future.
 - How do you apply principles in your group service structure, and what can ASC do to better support principal-based service?
 - How do you train your trusted servants, is there mentorship, how can ASC better train members in service?
 - Some other topic or best practice that your group thinks will benefit all members of ASC to present during an ASC open forum.

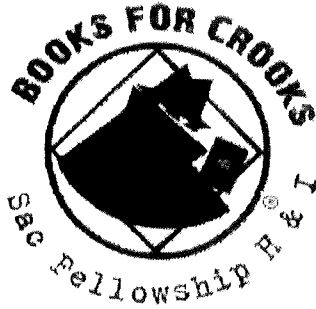
