# **PUBLIC RELATIONS REPORT**

# PUBLIC COMMUNICATIONS

Arlene Francis Center – NA Event Listing Concern: A couple of members of NA brought a concern to PR regarding a meeting flyer posted on the center's events page and the Press Democrat. While NA's Guiding Principles (Tradition 6) state that it's acceptable for facilities to list NA meetings to help addicts find us, it must be clear that they are not providing NA services. Unfortunately, the flyer in question included the wording "Arlene Francis Center Presents," which gives the impression that the center is hosting the NA meeting.

PR communicated with the trusted servants of that meeting. It was suggested to remove the wording: "Arlene Francis Center Presents," from the flyer and event description to avoid confusion and stay aligned with our traditions. It was a simple mistake, and it's now being corrected.

# COMMUNITY PRESENTATIONS

On March 28 and 31: Eleven NA volunteers shared the message of recovery at Petaluma High, speaking to four classrooms of about 15–20 students each. A teacher also offered to write a letter that PR can use as a reference for outreach to Santa Rosa schools.
