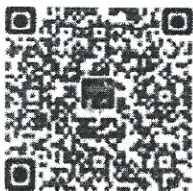
All our time slots are currently covered with at least one person — thank you all for your service! However, we haven't seen any new volunteers signing up lately.

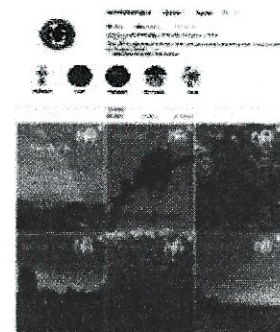

– No, fire camp clearance must be done separately through CDCR.

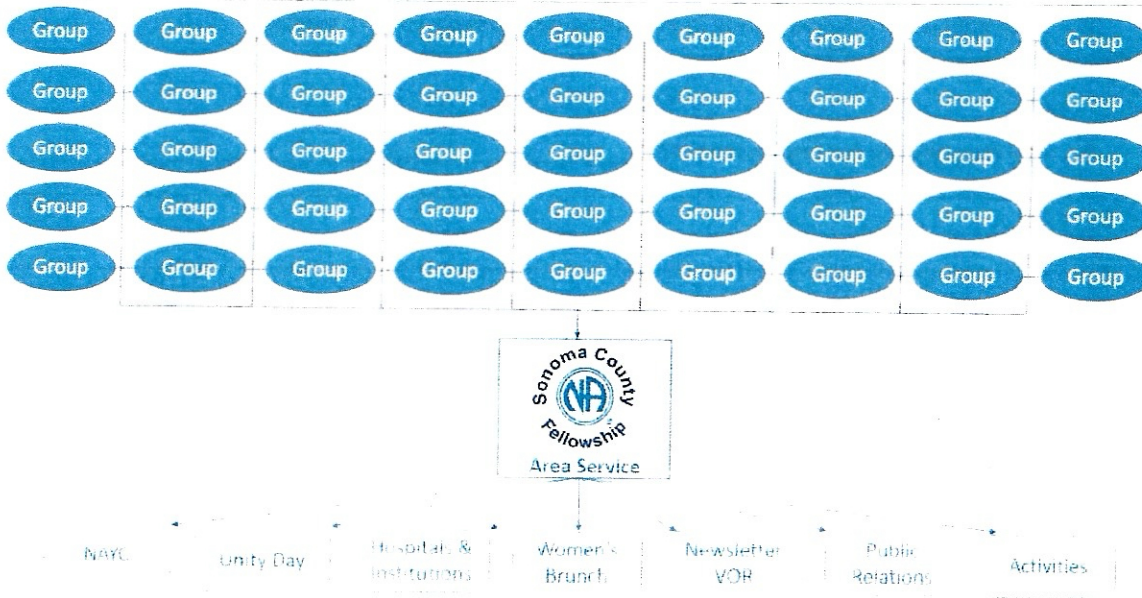
