Qualifications:


- Two years clean time with recovery centered in NA. One year commitment to the position, maintains financial stability and can handle money responsibly.





- Make a motion to area to cover the expenses. Is there a way for the facilities to contact someone to make sure the rent is getting paid to prevent this from happening.
- Lack of financial transparency, Groups and Areas need to follow the guidelines to ensure accountability. It is principles not personalities / Use funds wisely
- Groups use a Treasurer Book for accountability. The ASC is responsible to protect NA as a whole
- Falls on the trusted servants should understand what needs to be done in the position. 4th Concept
- Longstanding group that folded and did not pay rent for two months Miracle that happened was that the GSRs pulled money out of their pocket to cover the expense when ASC wouldn't

Dogs in Meetings: What is the Policy Service Dogs. What happens when we know they are not a service dog?

- Include a printed sheet that includes information on service animals & read it in format
- Put sign on door so people see it before they walk in to the meeting
- If someone with a dog refuses to leave, shut the meeting down

From our Insurance Packet:

Service animal means any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability. Other species of animals, whether wild or domestic, trained or untrained, are not service animals for the purposes of this definition. The work or tasks performed by a service animal must be directly related to the handler's disability. The presence of ANY animal not meeting the ADA definition of "Service Animal" could cause a claim to be denied by NCRSO's insurance company. There are two questions that can legally be asked when it is not obvious what service an animal provides; only limited inquiries are allowed. The two questions are: (1) Is the dog a service animal required because of a disability? (2) What work or task has the dog been trained to perform? Members cannot ask about the person's disability, require medical documentation, require a special identification card or training documentation for the dog, or ask that the dog demonstrate its ability to perform the work or task. By paying careful attention to the information provided in this document, groups can help ensure the financial welfare of Narcotics Anonymous by avoiding unnecessary legal conflicts.
